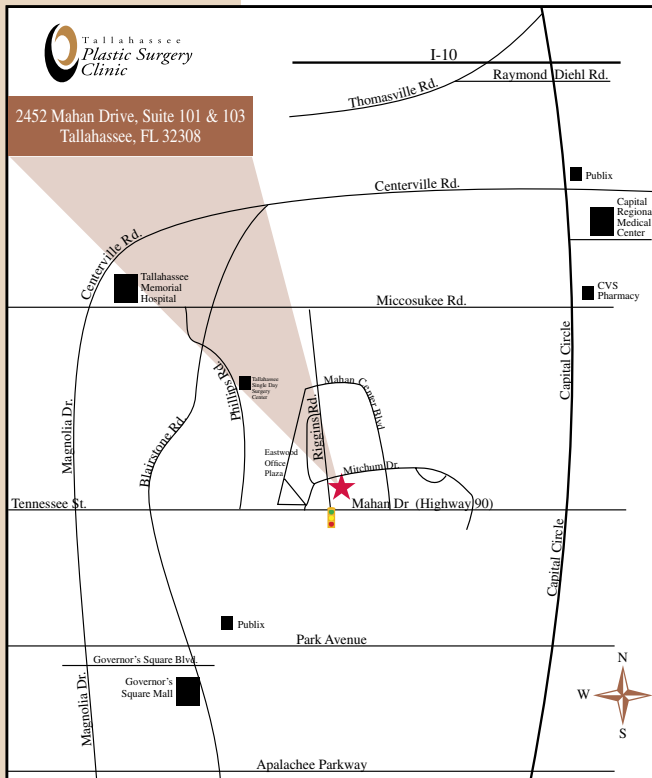

FROM THE SOUTH

Take US 90 to Magnolia Street - go East on Mahan Drive / US 90 for approximately 1.6 miles. Turn left at light at Riggins Road. Turn in to first driveway on right at Mahan Center, make an immediate right turn into first parking lot driveway; look for stone building at the top of parking lot.

FROM THE EAST

Take US 90 E or I-10 west towards Capital Circle NE - US 319. Pass through intersection of Capital Circle to Riggins Road, approximately .6 miles on the right. Turn right at light at Riggins Road. Turn in to first driveway on right at Mahan Center, make an immediate right turn into first parking lot driveway; look for stone building at the top of parking lot.

FROM THE NORTH

Take Thomasville Road / US 319, merge onto US 319 S via the ramp on the left toward I-10 E. Continue 3.7 miles and turn right on Mahan Drive / US 90 W. Turn right at light at Riggins Road. Turn right in to first driveway at Mahan Center, make an immediate right into first parking lot driveway; look for stone building at top of parking lot.

FROM THE WEST

Take I 10 toward Lake City Take the SR-61 B; exit - Exit 203 toward US 319/Thomasville Road for approximately .2 miles. Merge onto Raymond Diehl Rd., continue .2 miles. Turn right onto Capital Circle, US-319/FL for 3.2 miles. Turn right onto Mahan Drive / US 90, continue .6 miles. Turn right at light at Riggins Road. Turn right in to first driveway at Mahan Center, make an immediate right into first parking lot driveway; look for stone building at top of parking lot.

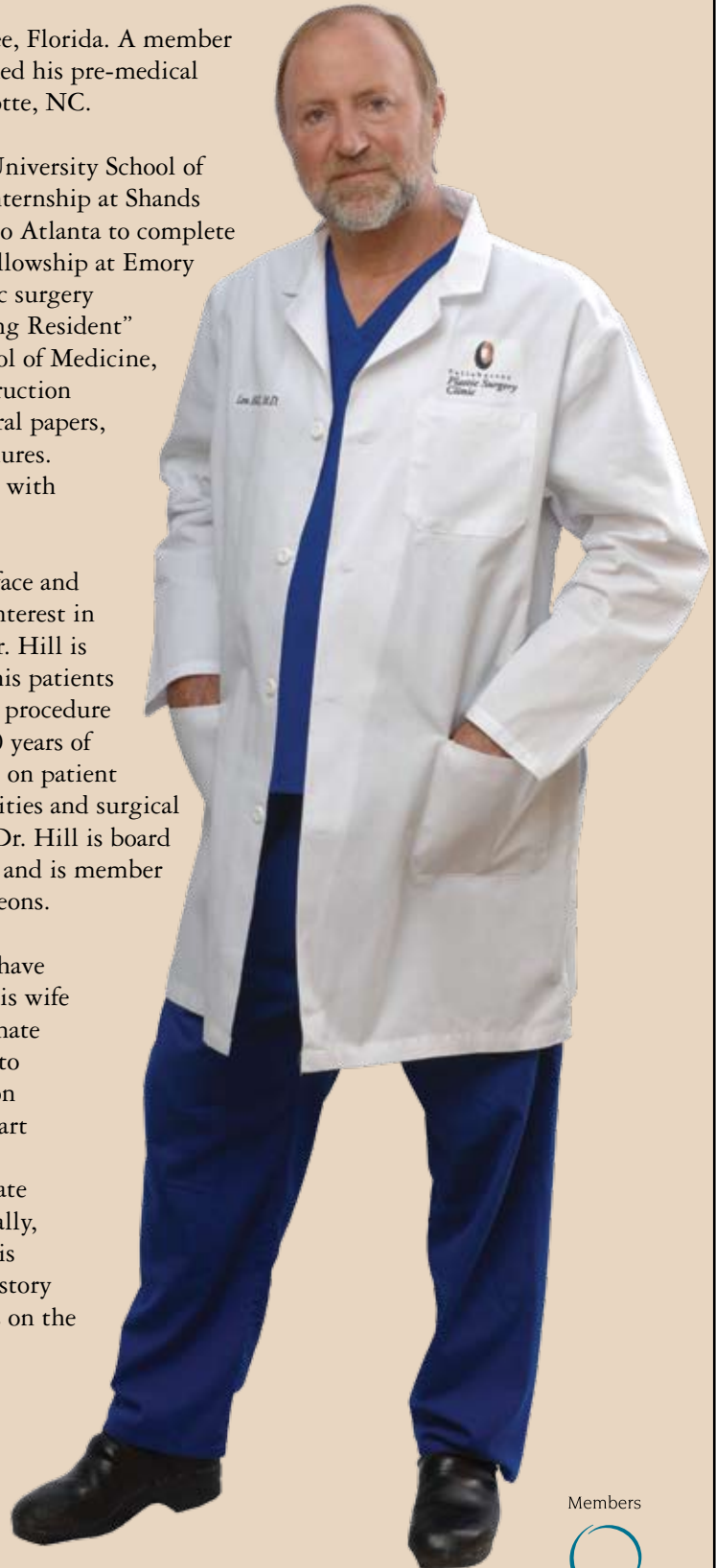
LOUIS HILL, JR., M.D.

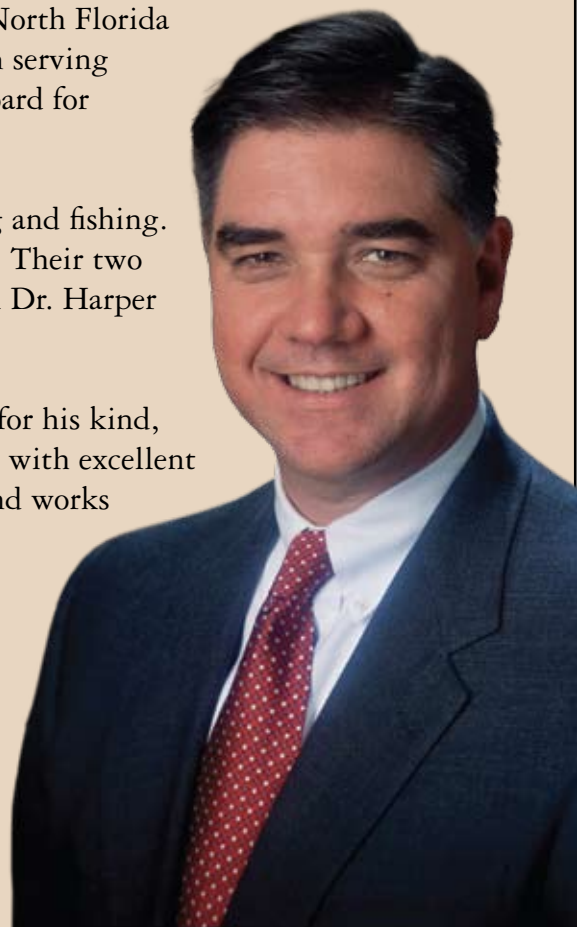

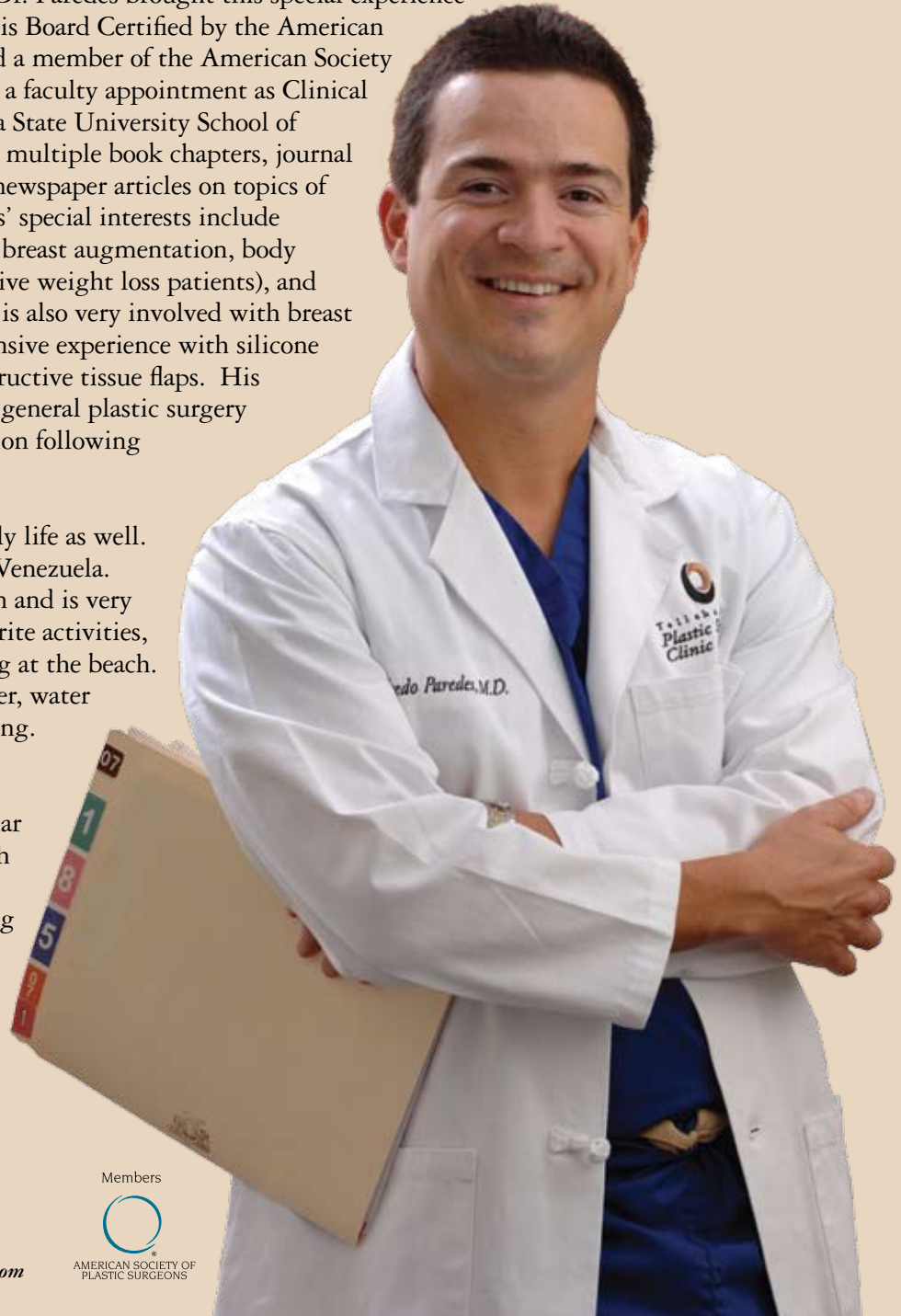


ALFREDO A. PAREDES, JR., M.D.
